**Junior employees working as liquor service employees must be paid at the adult rate of pay for the classification for the work being performed (see clause 13.5). An employer may demand the production of a birth certificate etc for the purpose of ascertaining the correct age of a junior employee. Any person who has completed a full apprenticeship as a qualified tradesperson must be paid not less than the standard adult rate.
